Outagamie County Department of Health and Human Services-Appleton

Crisis Intervention

Includes confidential telephone counseling for a variety of problems. Emergency psychiatric evaluation and short-term counseling by mental health staff available. Staff has the ability to trace a call and send police out to an address in the event of a life-threatening emergency.

Mental Health Services

Psychological evaluation of and psychotherapy for emotional and behavior problems, excluding crisis and chronic mental illness. Provides individual, group, marital and family therapy for Outagamie County residents.

Winnebago County Department of Human Services-Oshkosh and Neenah

Crisis Intervention/Helpline

Includes confidential telephone counseling for a variety of problems. Staff has the ability to trace a call and send police out to an address in the event of a life-threatening emergency.

Short- and long-term counseling for children, adolescents and families

Accepts third party, MA, pro bono and sliding scale

Winnebago County Department of Human Services-Oshkosh

Prevention Program

Underage Drinking Diversion Program, Tobacco Coalition

Winnebago County Department of Human Services-Oshkosh

Family Support Program

Provides funding for services for eligible children and families.

Must be developmentally disabled, physically disabled, or severely emotionally disturbed and age 18 or under.

Accepts third party, Network Health Plan, MA, BadgerCare. No pro bono or sliding scale.

Affinity Medical Group-Psychology Department-Oshkosh

Accept third party, Network Health Plan, BadgerCare, pro bono or sliding scale, or NHP MA with prior authorization.

Agnesian Health Care– Outpatient Behavioral Health-Fond du Lac

No insurance information listed.

Appleton Psychiatric and Counseling Center-Appleton

Accepts third party and some Touchpoint UBH. No MA.

Aurora Behavioral Health-Oshkosh

Accepts third party, Point of Service, MA with secondary insurance, Touchpoint, pro bono and sliding scale.

Appleton Veterans Administration (VA) Community Based Outpatient Clinic

Most insurances accepted. Medicare, Tricare, and Champus not accepted.

Catholic Charities-Appleton and Oshkosh

Accepts third party, Network Health Plan, Touchpoint Select and Preferred, UBH, MA, sliding scale and NHP/MA.

Accepts MA, insurance and sliding fee scale assessment

Accepts third party, sliding scale. Does not accept MA.

Accepts Prevea, MA, Medicare, Medicaid, Humana, Network Health Plan

Oshkosh Counseling Center

Accepts Health Management Center, Network Health Plan, sliding scale, WEA and Tricare

Psychiatric Consultants, SC-Oshkosh

Accepts third party; can see Network Health Plan patients by referral but not Network Health Plan-MA .

Psychological Associates of the Fox Cities-Appleton

No HMO's, No MA, Medicaid or Medicare. Accepts third party or private pay.

Reach Counseling Services-Oshkosh and Menasha

Accepts most insurances, MA, sliding fee scale. Education, advocacy and child therapist services provided free.

Samaritan Counseling Center (formerly Fox Valley Pastoral Counseling Center)-Oshkosh and Menasha

Accepts third party, Network Health Plan, Medicare, MA, sliding scale, United HC. No Touchpoint.

Theda Care Behavioral Health – Appleton

Accepts third party, Touchpoint, some Network Health Plan

Theda Care Behavioral Health-Menasha

Accepts third party insurance

Theda Care Behavioral Health-Oshkosh

Accepts third party, UBH, United Health, other major insurances.

Theda Clark Medical Center - Mental Health Day Program-Neenah

Accepts third party, WMA, Medicare

Wellness Counseling Center-Appleton

Most insurance plans accepted; No MA, sliding scale, or pro bono accepted.

Transitions Counseling

Accepts third party insurance

Wisconsin Family Growth and Reconciliation Center-Oshkosh

Many insurance accepted including Network Health Plan. No Managed Care, Medicare, MA, sliding scale, Badgercare, Champus, or Tricare accepted.

INPATIENT UNITS

Mercy Medical Center-Adult Inpatient Psychiatric Unit-Oshkosh

Assessment and treatment for acute mental health or detox problems for persons age 17 years and older.

Accepts third party, Network Health Plan, WMA, UBH Network, Medicare

Bed Availability: 11 inpatient beds

St. Elizabeth Hospital-Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Unit-Appleton

Inpatient and day treatment programs for acute psychiatric problems of children aged 6-18 or 19 if still in high school. Accepts all insurances except Touchpoint, MA requires prior assessment All insurances need prior authorization.

Bed Availability: 13 beds, usually 2 beds open for emergencies

Theda Clark Medical Center-Adult Inpatient Psychiatric Unit-Neenah

Assessment and treatment for detox and acute mental health problems for persons age 18 years and older. AODA assessment is also done on campus. Provides educational groups, OT and music therapy.

Accepts third party, WMA, Medicare. No Network Health Plan.

Bed Availability: 12 inpatient beds, 2 restraint/seclusion beds

Winnebago Mental Health Institute-Inpatient Program-Oshkosh

Consists of 4 admission/treatment units that provide assessment and treatment of children aged 5-17.

Admissions are arranged through county social services referrals only. Has Waterwood Day School program.

Accepts private insurance and MA with prior authorization; County Social Services needs to give prior authorization.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Berry (Robert E.) House, Inc.-Fond du Lac

Provides services to residents who are diagnosed with some form of mental illness.

Insurance: Call for information

Eligibility: Age 18 or over, referral required.

Boys and Girls Club of Oshkosh, Inc.

Provides education and recreation programs for children aged 6 to 18. Also, provides care for children of working parents after school.

Catholic Charities-Oshkosh

Pregnancy Counseling

Provides assistance in accessing community resources that relate to pregnancy. Provides counseling services for women who are making a parenting or adoption plan for their child. Also provides case management services. No fee.

Adoption Services

Stepparent adoption, domestic infant adoption, international adoption, independent adoption. Fee varies.

Center for Career Development and Employability Training-Oshkosh

An outreach of the UWO and CCDET; provides direct services to youth and young adults in the greater Fox Cities area. Primary services for youth are truancy intervention and pre-employment training. Some eligibility requirements apply. The OASD Restorative Justice Family Advocate works in conjunction with K12 students, families and school staff to resolve conflict and provide alternatives to traditional school-based discipline options.

Insurance: N/A

Christine Ann Domestic Abuse Services, Inc.-Oshkosh

Provides shelter for victims of domestic abuse. Can accept individuals and/or custodial parents with children/teens. The shelter can accept victims below 18 years of age if they are married or emancipated by court order. A Children and Teen Program is available for both resident and non-resident youth requesting services. No fee.

Community Outreach Center – Appleton

Exists as a federal grant to serve the chronically mentally ill who are homeless or at risk of being homeless. Primary services include assessment and referral to appropriate services, which include psychiatric mental health services and assistance with housing, clothing and other basic needs (including medical). Drop-in center open 365 days a year for people who are diagnosed with a chronic mental illness. No fee. Area Served: Calumet, Outagamie, and Winnebago counties

Delta Center, LLC-Fond du Lac

Providing counseling services to children, adolescents, adults, families, couples and individuals. Psychiatric services available.

Father Carr's Place 2B-Oshkosh

Daily free lunch and supper. Emergency shelter for kids with their families and mens shelter. (Crisis must be called for runaways.) AIDS testing and screening available. Free St. Francis walk-in clinic. Food bank every Friday from 9 AM to Noon. No fee.

Financial Information and Service Center (FISC)-Menasha

Consumer credit counseling agency, also teaching money management classes. No insurance accepted.

Fox Cities Community Health Center-Menasha

Provide access to primary care medical services to underserved residents.

Eligibility: Residents of Outagamie, Winnebago or Calumet County

Fee: Sliding scale based on income verification

Franklin House-Fond du Lac

16-bed CBRF serving older individuals who have mental health diagnoses and medical health issues, i.e. diabetes, blood pressure, etc.

Insurance: N/A, Call for eligibility and fee info.

Hmong Service Provider-Oshkosh

Assistance with the well-being and interests of Southeast Asians and other minorities.

Eligibility: Call for information

Oshkosh Family, Inc.

Corporate guardian licensed by the State of Wisconsin.

Eligibility: Call for information

Fee: Donation only

Oshkosh Fire Department

Juvenile Fire Setters Program

Service: Counseling for juveniles 13 or younger who like to play with matches or fire. No fee.

Oshkosh Seniors Center

Services include nail care, fitness assessments, health screenings and workshops for people who are struggling to live with chronic conditions. Fee: Only if under age 60. Donations only.

Oshkosh/Winnebago County Housing Authority

Provide affordable housing, economic opportunity and suitable living environment. Payment plans accepted.

Salvation Army-Oshkosh

Agency geared at serving the community. Offers meals twice a day, church services, casework with health problems, food pantry, diapers, and a thrift store. No fee.

Towards Tomorrow-Oshkosh

12-bed CBRF for people with a primary mental illness. Some crisis and AODA evaluation available.

Eligibility: Referral from County required

Winnebago Mental Health Institute

Foster Grandparents Program

Works with special needs children at Winnebago Mental Health Institute

Eligibility: Must be over 60 Fee: Call for information

Youth-Go Inc.-Neenah

Individual and group counseling, mentoring, prevention programs for pregnancy, alcohol and drug use, and violence. Referral is made to appropriate agencies for more serious problems and emergencies. No fee.

GRIEF SUPPORT GROUPS OR PROGRAMS

A Time to Mourn

Six-week grief group offering support for adults who have experienced the death of an adult loved one. Co-led by professionals trained in grief support. Offered three times per year.

Camp Hope-Rosholt

Weekend program providing an atmosphere of love and acceptance for children following the death of a loved one. Camp is held at the Wisconsin Lions Camp near Rosholt, WI on May 19-20 and October 6-7, 2007. Now features adult camps as well – for parents or caregivers of children who are attending camp. No fee.

Center for Grieving Children-Appleton

Monthly peer-to-peer support group for grieving children ages 3 to 18 and their families. Led by trained facilitators and volunteers. Includes supper. No fee.

Community for Hope of Greater Oshkosh, Inc.-Oshkosh

Nonprofit organization dedicated to suicide prevention, intervention and response.

SOS (Survivors of Suicide) Groups: Support groups for those who have lost someone to suicide. No fee.

Compassionate Friends-Neenah and Oshkosh

Support group for parents who have had a child die. No fee.

Grief Support for widows/widowers-Appleton

Topic based gathering for widows and widowers. No fee.

Grief Support--Drop-In Groups-Appleton and Oshkosh

Open to any adult grieving the death of a loved one. Refreshments and handouts are provided. No fee.

Living with Loss-Appleton

Six-week grief group offering support to adults who have experienced the loss of a loved one. Offered in Fall, Winter and Spring at ThedaCare Home Hospice. No fee.

Men Only Grief Support Group

Drop-in group; includes home cooked meal, discussion, sharing, and support.

NAMI Fox Valley Support Programs-Appleton *NAMI = National Alliance for Mental Illness*

PROGRAM: 5 O'Clock Friday Group

This is a new NAMI support group for young adults aged 18 to 25 who have a mental illness. (18 y/o should be out of high school). This group is facilitated by two trained consumers. This group will have a strong focus on recovery and empowerment including discussion on topics such as higher education, work, and healthy relationships.

PROGRAM: Family to Family

Led by family members for family members. Provides in-depth information about biological brain disorders, including schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, bipolar disorder, depression, and anxiety disorders. Participants study brain biology and functions, learn how medications work, and learn how to be better listeners and communicators with their ill relative.

PROGRAM: Family Sharing Sessions

Professional meets with family members who are seeking help and information to cope with and understand a relative's mental illness.

PROGRAM: New Hope Consumer Support Group

Consumer-run support groups for adults that provide a safe and caring environment in which to express feelings and concerns about living with a mental illness. The primary purpose of these groups is to provide support and information. Social activities are also a part of the programming.

PROGRAM: Peer to Peer

Similar in mission and format to Family to Family course, Peer to Peer follows a definite curriculum and serves to educate and support consumers about mental illness.

PROGRAM: Provider Education Program

Designed to address the emerging role of mental health workers and professionals, this 10-week, 30 hour program gives mental health providers a perspective on the impact mental illness has on a consumer. Teaching team is a mental health professional, two family members, and two consumers.

PROGRAM: Teen Support Group
